What are your aspirations in life?


My aspirations in life are to grow as a teacher and show my knowledge to as many people as possible.



What does an ordinary day in your life look like?


A typical day for me is a balance between pursuing my hobbies and attending lessons with my in-person tutors. I try to make the most of my time by engaging in activities.
